NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING Proposed Increase of Water Rates

Explanation of Monthly Water Meter and Usage Charge Increase and Surcharge

The CCSD Board of Directors has proposed an increase to all water rates to be paid by CCSD customers, subject to a public hearing. If adopted, the proposed monthly base rate and water usage charge increases will take effect on January 20, 2024 and the surcharge on February 1, 2024. A detailed table of proposed rates for a five-year plan is provided at the end of this notice.

CCSD owns and manages the water resources of the District, along with the sewer system and the wastewater treatment facilities of the District.

Revenue generated from customer water and sewer bills is used to pay for the ongoing operation, maintenance, and repair of the water and sewer systems. It will be necessary to implement base rate increases to keep up with the high rate of inflation and the need to maintain equipment and facilities of an aging infrastructure.

When a Complaint for Comprehensive Groundwater Adjudication of the Cuyama Valley Groundwater Basin was filed in 2021, CCSD contracted Best Best & Krieger, Attorneys at Law, for their professional services to represent CCSD and protect its rights to supply water to its customers. Although the importance of representation is realized, these legal fees had a significant impact on the District's operating expenses at a cost of nearly \$45,000 last fiscal year. It is anticipated that this trend will continue and create more financial hardship; therefore, a surcharge will be necessary to cover legal fees until the Adjudication case is settled, at which time the surcharge will end.

How to Participate in the Process

Interested parties can comment on the proposed rate increases. California law prohibits the District from implementing the proposed rate increases if a majority of **property owners** of record on identified CCSD accounts file a written protest opposing the proposed rate increases and surcharge before the end of the public hearing.

Written protests must be submitted to Cuyama Community Services District, at 4853 Primero Street, New Cuyama, CA 93254, **or** PO Box 368 **(not postmarked)** by the close of the public hearing on November 16, 2023. Oral comments at the public hearing will not qualify as a formal protest unless accompanied by a written protest. Each protest must identify the affected property (by assessor's parcel number or street address) and include the signature of the property owner.

If you are NOT the property owner, please forward this notice to the owner immediately.

PROPOSED WATER CHARGES AND SURCHARGE

CCSD is empowered with the responsibility of operating sufficient water and sewer system services for its stakeholders. The District strives to maintain optimal operations while conducting business in the best interest of its customers.

The District operates a water system comprised of groundwater production wells, storage tanks, an arsenic removal treatment plant, booster pumps and distribution pipelines. The sewer system includes a wastewater collection system, a treatment plant, and evaporation ponds.

In order to continue to provide reliable services to customers, the District proposes to increase revenue over the next five fiscal years. The proposed increase to the current base rate and water usage charges for fiscal year 2024 would be 42%, and there would be no increase for fiscal year 2025. The increase to the base rate and water usage charges would be 7% for each of the next three fiscal years (FY26, FY27, and FY28). The chart below displays the proposed monthly increase to the base rate and uniform water usage rate over the five-year revenue plan.

The surcharge of \$20.00 per month would remain in effect until the Adjudication case is settled. These funds would be used expressly for legal fees associated with the Adjudication matter and would not be used for normal operations of the system.

The table below shows proposed monthly charges. Revenue is based on the meter size of 230 connections using an average water usage of 18 units per month (1 unit = 100 cubic feet or 748 gallons).
